Mr. Rodrigues,

I had a master calendar today where the attorney of record, [REDACTED], failed to appear. Her clients also did not appear – [REDACTED] [REDACTED] respectively.

We called the attorney on the record and she claimed she no longer worked at the law firm of Amoachi & Johnson. She claimed to have left that law firm in June 2018. However, I listened to the DAR and reviewed the E-28, and both demonstrate that she appeared before this Court on [REDACTED] 2018, as an associate of said firm. She also agreed to inform her clients of the consequences for failure to appear.

She also claimed that her notice of hearing had a date for March 2018, but the notice clearly demonstrates that counsel was, on [REDACTED] 2018, given a notice of hearing scheduling the case for [REDACTED] 2019 at 8 AM. She claims that she was no longer at the firm Amoachi & Johnson, but we called that firm's phone number to talk to her, and the attorney directory at nycourts.gov demonstrate that she still works at Amoachi & Johnson. (I have placed a copy of the nycourts.gov directory page with the attorney's information in the ROP.)

I don't know if she was confused, but whether or not she currently works at Amoachi & Johnson, she and her clients were on notice that they needed to appear today. Please let my legal assistant [REDACTED] [REDACTED] know what documents you will need for this referral. Thank you.
